




Directions:


Mrs. Claus just finished baking 54 cookies. Santa ate 3 of them and the elves ate 12. How many cookies are left?




23 children asked for a doll for Christmas. 16 children asked for a teddy bear. How many more children asked for a doll than a teddy bear?




It takes Mrs. Matthews Z hours 15 minutes to decorate the gingerbread house. If she begins decorating at 1:30 pm, what time does she finish?


